In Dec. 2014, the Indianapolis City-County Council approved a storm water user fee rate adjustment that may change your storm water utility fee. Storm water utility fees for all types of property are now calculated based on the City's measurement of the impervious surface area on your parcel. Indy citizens will be able view the amount of impervious surface area on their properties and the specific fee amount by using an online customer service database.

Join Public Works staff at either of 2 public meetings to ask questions about the rate adjustment and see a demonstration of how to use the customer service interface tool to look up your specific parcel and storm water utility fee amount.
